Award

- UMHEF will provide a limited number of \$1,000 matching scholarships. Eligible applicants who do not receive matching funds from the UMHEF will still be eligible for a \$1,000 match from the educational institution.
- Upon verification of full-time enrollment in the fall, UMHEF will transfer \$2,000 to the school (church and UMHEF funds) if the

student was

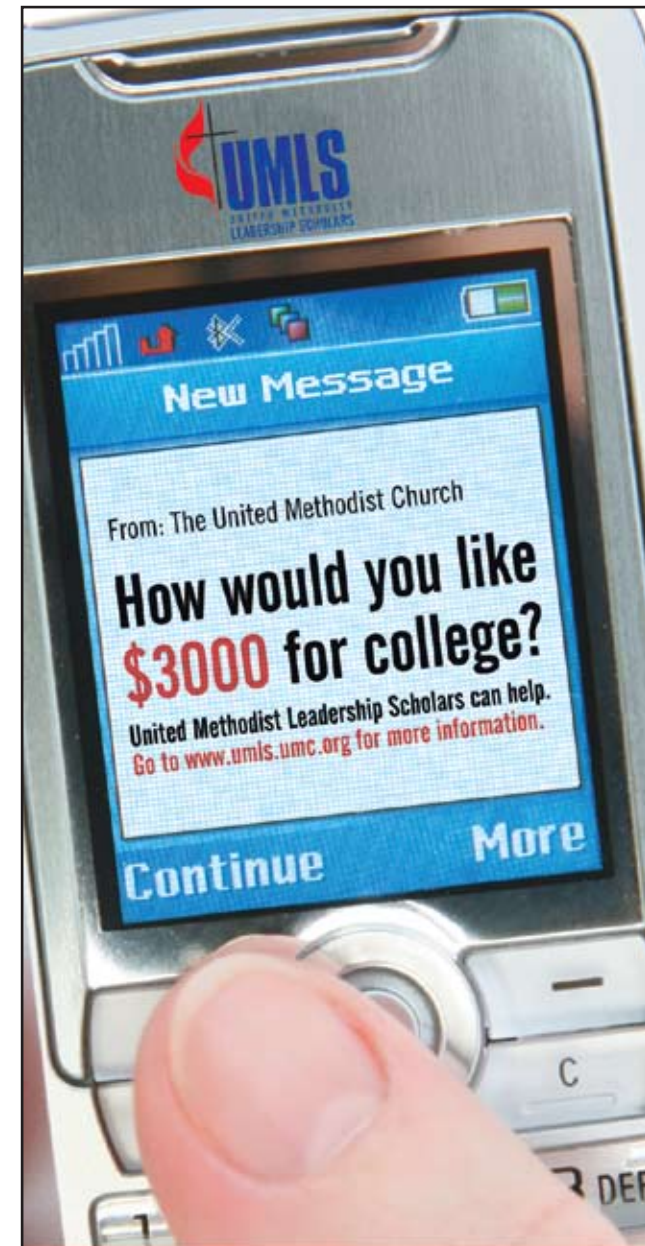
awarded UMHEF matching funds OR UMHEF will transfer \$1,000 (church funds) to the school if the student was not awarded UMHEF matching funds.

- Students should expect to receive an additional \$1,000 matching award directly from their school.

The United Methodist Leadership Scholars (UMLS) program is sponsored by United Methodist Churches in the southeast and the colleges and universities listed as participating institutions. UMLS is supported by the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry (GBHEM) and the United Methodist Higher Education Foundation (UMHEF).

This scholarship program is designed to encourage active United Methodist students to attend a United Methodist-related college or university by offering up to \$3,000 in scholarship funds. It is hoped that the transformational experiences available at our United Methodist colleges and universities will guide students to make vocational choices for Christian service to church and society and that these students will emerge as leaders — lay and clergy — of The United Methodist Church.

Through the UMLS program, local churches are encouraged to provide \$1,000 scholarships on behalf of students planning to enroll in a participating United Methodist-related college or university. These institutions have agreed to match local church funds for a total award of \$2,000. In addition, UMHEF has agreed to provide a limited number of \$1,000 matching scholarships for a total award of \$3,000 (local church, UMHEF, and school funds).

Application Deadline

- Applications for the program should be received in the UMHEF office no later than **April 1**.

Application Process

- **Churches may register all 9-12 grade students** using the church leaders student registration form online at uMLS-students.umc.org.
- **Download the United Methodist Leadership Scholars Application from uMLS.umc.org** by clicking on “Student Application for UMLS Scholarship” under the Visitor Center section. Students may submit only one application.
- **UMLS is a point-of-entry scholarship only.** Applicants must be first-time enrollees in a United Methodist-related higher education institution (any class status) to be eligible for a UMLS award. Applicants must also be active members of The United Methodist Church (for at least one year) and planning to enroll full-time in the fall at a participating United Methodist-related college or university.
- **Ineligible and incomplete applications will be returned unfunded to the sponsoring church along with the church check.**
- **A check for \$1,000 payable to UMHEF from the sponsoring church must be mailed along with the fully completed application form.** Churches may submit an unlimited number of applicants for this scholarship program. Please note that churches submitting funds agree to allow the educational institution an opportunity to present the scholarship to the student at the church.
